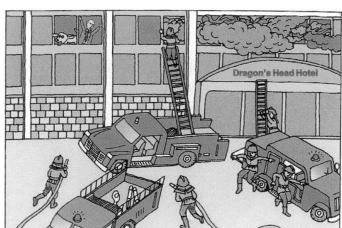

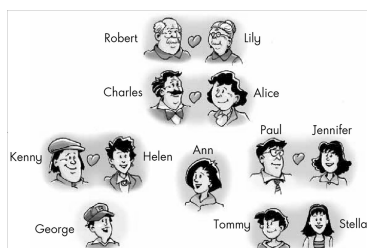

It's fun when you have a pet dog in your family, but a few days later, you may cry, "He won't stop barking!", or "Why does he eat everything?" So, do you really know how to care for a puppy?

Children love dogs, and dogs love children, too. You can teach your dog to sit, lie down, and even play games with him, but you should not be cruel to him — don't hit him. And you'd better not feed him from the table so that he will not become a "beggar". When he looks ill, you should take him to the animal hospital.

You can teach your dog to sit without touching him; just show him a snack. Hold the food above his head so he has to look up to see it. If he sits, tell him, "good boy!" If you hold the snack too high, he'll jump to get it, so just hold it high enough. If he walks away instead of sitting, let him smell the food, then move it a bit higher.

Soon, your dog will know it's time to sit when he sees you give him his dinner or a snack. Then you can add the word "sit". Use it when you want to give him food. And you know, your pet dog learns quickly.
